To some, it is the Street of Shame. But lurking behind Fleet Street's screaming headlines—and its enthusiasm over the Reuters bonanza—lies the awesome power of its print workers. Roy Thomson, who owned the *Sunday Times* from 1959 to his death in 1976, visited the newspaper shortly after he acquired it. "I'm Roy Thomson, the new owner of this paper," he Canadian publisher in greeting. "You may own it," snapped one

native, "but I run it." Thomson explained an uncomfortable measure of truth. Over the years, the unions have accumulated power over their own print rooms to the unions able to give in to yet another small demand rather than

Over 35 years, three successive Royal Commissions have reached the conclusion that the industry's continuing financial woes are primarily due to union practices, particularly to widespread overstaffing. The most recent commission, in 1977, found that new technology would allow newspapers to produce 10 million a year in labor. The rewards today would be higher still.

At the cost of battling the unions, the industry's financial position is high. In 1978 the Reuters Newspaper Group announced that it would reject the unions' demand for an introduction of new technology. The newspaper suffered a pretax loss of \$82 million.

The stranglehold of the unions is not to be broken. None has been able to do so. Staffing disputes between the unions and Fleet Street some \$40 million a year. The unions, it is said, have been overpaid.
